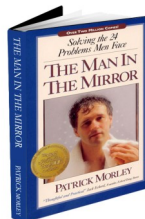

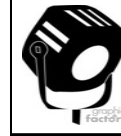
Admission is free! Snacks will be available for purchase from the H2O Youth Group Concession Stand.
